## August 20, 2018 Meeting Minutes

Members present: 38

President Marlin Roseland called the meeting to order and members recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The July 2018 minutes and treasurer's reports were read. A motion was made by Rich Shangreaux, seconded by Dale Hunsley, to approve the minutes; motion carried. A motion was made by Rich Shangreaux, seconded by Kale Urban, to accept the treasurer's report; motion carried. Roxie Thielen was authorized to pay remaining outstanding Dam Run bills.

**Member Accolades and Concerns:** Marlin Roseland thanked all members participating in a very successful 2018 Dam Run. Sympathy to Frank Eich. Deb's memorial service is Saturday, August 25, 11 a.m. at the United Methodist Church. Members attending are asked to drive their classic vehicle; Dave Hausmann will have space designated to park the vehicles. A motion was made by Rich Shangreaux, seconded by Cale Zickrick, to give a \$100 memorial in Deb Eich's honor; motion carried. Continue sending prayers to Tom Murphy for continued health improvements.

### Committee Reports:

- **Dam Run** - Chairman Kale Urban, praised all members for helping make the event a success. Several positive comments were received on how seamless the events were conducted. Exiting from the show-n-shine using the two exits worked great and helped get participants on to the poker run. Gravity drags went well as did the Saturday evening meal where everyone was served in record time. The cruise was led by GF&P; some concern that the pace was too slow, especially on 1804. The leader, however, was without a speedometer so that was part of the problem. Pierre police department was pleased with the cruise and traffic stop points in front of the Lariat, bottom of the Truck Route, and at the Fourth Street turn off from the Truck Route. Cruising down Fourth Street worked much better than going to the end of the Truck Route and Hwy 14. Thank you Patrick Callahan for the use of his sound system at the Show-n-Shine and during the awards at the Lariat.
  - Ardys Roseland reported that 173 shirts were ordered from RMS Printing in Rapid City. Service and quality was very good and a profit was made with shirts sold plus there are still 29 shirts remaining. The leftovers will be put on ebay to try to get some of those sold.
  - Plans for the August 9,10, & 11, 2019, 30th Dam Run need to begin soon. Kale and Beth Urban's awesome chairmanship efforts this year awarded them the honor of heading up the 2019 Dam Run. One suggestion to keep in mind is the possibility of having the Gearhead Reunion at Steamboat Park. Thank you to Dale and Kathy Hunsley for hosting the Dam Run leftover potluck.
- **Newsletter** - Everyone seems to be receiving the newsletter by email or in paper form when no email is available.
- **Membership** - Rich Shangreaux introduced and welcomed newest members in attendance, Scott and Donna Baye, Gene Wiczorek and Joann Beaird, and Keven and Marlena Klein. Other new members include Duane and Carol Schmutz, Marlin Johnson, and Matt and Karen LeBrun.
- **Scholarship** - Roxie Thielen will confirm attendance of the two scholarship recipients and have Bank West distribute the funds.
- **Cruise schedule** - Cale Zickrick has scheduled Drifters, Brewsters in Onida, Edgewood and DQ, and the Chuck-wagon for cruising in the upcoming weeks.

### Old Business:

- **Name tags** - Marlin Roseland explained the name tag penalty program while several members demonstrated how it works if name tags are not worn at meetings.
