Members present: 16

Meeting called to order by Ann Curtis, President. The February 2016 minutes and treasurer's report were adopted.

Ed Nill informed the club that he filed the 2016 annual nonprofit report with the Secretary of State as required by statute.

Old Business

Scholarship fund: Steve Brown reported that the scholarship application was sent to high schools in Hyde, Sully, Haakon, Hughes, Stanley, Lyman and Jones counties. It was suggested that the application also be sent to schools in Potter and Faulk counties; Steve will include those schools in the distribution. It was reiterated that if a scholarship was awarded that the funds would be sent directly to the institution of his/her choice and not actually given to the recipient of the scholarship. It was suggested that the application be posted on the website; Marlin Roseland will do that. The possibility that more than

one scholarship be awarded if there are worthy candidates was discussed. There was a consensus that this would be acceptable to the group if more than one worthy applicant is received. One scholarship application from Sully County had been received as of 3-21-16.
