### Committee Reports:

- **Dam Run** - Chairman Kale Urban is pleased with each committee's organization in preparation for the August Dam Run. Things seem to be in order. Another committee meeting will be scheduled in the near future for a final review to make sure everything is covered.
- **Newsletter/Website** - Marlin Roseland has been working on updates for the website; let him know if you have new pictures, information to add, or corrections. All members seem to be receiving the newsletter. Items for each newsletter can be submitted to Ardys Roseland.
