Members present: 32

President Marlin Roseland called the meeting to order followed with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The October 2018 minutes and treasurer's reports were read. A motion was made by Rich Shangreaux, seconded by Mike Denton, to approve the minutes with the date corrections noted; motion carried. A motion was made by William Seefeldt, seconded by Cale Zickrick, to accept the treasurer's report; motion carried.

Club Accolades and Concerns: Happy birthday to Bill Welch! Thoughts and prayers were extended to Randy Bollinger, Frank Eich, & Steve Brown for speedy recoveries from recent surgeries.

Committee Reports:

- **Dam Run** - Kale Urban, chairman, has been doing a lot of the initial leg work. He has worked with the City of Fort Pierre for all events to be held in Fort Pierre. The Duffy Center has been reserved for Friday through Sunday. The gearhead reunion will be in Lilly Park with the Silver Spur providing burgers/brats & beer for sale. The Saturday evening meal of pulled pork, baked beans, and macaroni salad will be at the Duffy Center catered by the Silver Spur. The cost to the club will be \$5 per plate unless a sponsor is obtained to cover that expense. A grant will be written to cover the \$600 Duffy Center Fee. The City of Fort Pierre has agreed to block off the road in front of the Duffy Center to the school leaving the school parking lot for citizen parking and traffic off the main highway. The show-n-shine will still be at the Capitol and the gravity drags at the Heritage Center. The Saturday cruise from the Duffy Center will go down Dakota out to Farm Island. Members voiced concern about leaving the Lariat since Frank Newcomb is a lifetime Street Masters member. It was suggested that Frank and downtown sponsors be notified of the planned change.
- **Newsletter/Website** – Everyone seems to be receiving the newsletters. Marlin Roseland asked members to review the website to make sure your information is accurate and what you want on the site. Continue to give Marlin new photos.
- **Membership** - No new members. Rich Shangreaux asked that potential member names be given to him to be contacted. Mark Hunsley, Dale's brother, was introduced as a visitor.
- **Cruise schedule** - Cale Zickrick may try to schedule a gathering after the first of the year.

Old Business:

- **Name Tags** - The new name tag order was received. Members needing to purchase extra name tags can do so at their cost. Current cost is \$3.50.
- **Christmas party** - RSVPs were due. The party is scheduled for Saturday, December 1. Social begins at 5 p.m., dinner at 6, and the gift exchange at 7. Each person wanting to participate brings a wrapped gift valued around \$20.

- **By-Laws** - The by-laws have been reviewed by the board of directors, with guidance from Chuck Poches, and will be distributed, as required, in writing to the whole membership in December. All members at the January meeting will vote on the proposed changes; changes require a 2/3 majority of the members attending the January meeting. Once final changes are adopted, the new by-laws will be filed with the Secretary of State.

- **Election** - The 2019-2020 officer elections will take place at the January meeting. Individuals wanting to nominate or volunteer for any positions can do so at the December Christmas Party or during the election process at the January meeting.

Next Meeting - No December meeting will be held. The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 21, at 7 p.m. with members wanting to order a meal gathering at 6 p.m. at Perkins. A motion was made by Frank Eich, seconded by Dale Hunsley, to adjourn the meeting; motion carried.
