An individual in Nebraska happened to catch them traveling South and posted the video as something you do not see every day. Our sympathy to Connie Jones and her family in the death

#### **Committee Reports:**

- **Dam Run** - August 10-12, 2018 is set for the Dam Run.
- **Website** - Marlin Roseland continues to update website as information and pictures are submitted.

- **Scholarship** - Steve Brown is distributing applications; the application will be on our website.
