President Marlin Roseland called the meeting to order at the Pub/View 34 which will be our new meeting location each month. No December meeting.

The October 2017 minutes and treasurer’s reports were read and adopted as submitted.

Committee Reports:

- **Dam Run – Looking for a chairperson by January.**
- **Website – Marlin Roseland continues to update as information and pictures are shared with him.**
- **Membership – No new memberships received. Rich Shangreaux will follow-up with those who had shown interest. Rich is working with All Around Graphics for options for club caps.
