Club accolades: Jack Whaley, recipient of a 2017 club scholarship, thanked the club for the scholarship toward his schooling at LATI. Travis Hill, recipient of a 2016 club scholarship, thanked the club for the funding assistance and explained that the funds assisted with the purchase of tools required for his schooling at LATI.
