STREET MASTERS MEETING SUMMARY – February 20th,2017

Street Masters Minutes

February 20, 2017

Members Present: 19

President Marlin Roseland called the meeting to order.

January 2017 minutes and treasures report were adopted.

Committee Reports:

- Dam Run – Chairman, Frank Eich, is working on needed paperwork to reserve the various venues and talking with the city. Will have committee sign-up sheets at the March meeting and will get a flyer ready for distribution.
- Public relations – Marlin is adding upcoming rod run dates to the website. Requested more pictures of member vehicles. He will be updating the membership list online and removing those that are no longer members.
- Membership – No report. Deb Eich will print a few Street Masters information cards that members can have to share with potential members.
- Scholarship – Chairman, Steve Brown, reported that the 2017 application is ready for distribution. If scholarships are awarded, Steve and Roxie Thielen will authorize Bank West to make the appropriate payment(s). Scholarships should be announced in May with payment to the recipient’s postsecondary school in the fall.

Old Business:

- Magnetic name tags – Steve Brown is getting a list of names the supplier has already made and then will order for members who have never received a name tag.
- Plaques – Ryan Ellerton reported that the 15 plaques purchased by the club are here. The purchase price was \$400. Members voted unanimously to sell plaques to club members for \$35 each.
- Fort Pierre Bi-Centennial – No additional information.

New Business:

- Club t-shirts – Ryan and Monacha Ellerton have been working with Two-Lane Apparel, Rapid City, on a possible design for a club t-shirt. Price and quality of the shirts are good; plus service appears to be good. There would be a \$12 setup fee; small to extra-large shirts would cost \$6.50 and larger shirts would cost \$8. A sample design was shared. If we proceed with this project, members would need to agree on a vehicle to include in the design. If members want a shirt using their own vehicle in the design, they would need to pay their own \$12 setup fee. Members suggested that the shirts be sold for \$10 to cover the basic setup fee. Ryan collected orders at the meeting and is to have a proposal for the March meeting. The club would initially pay for the shirts with members reimbursing the club.
- Dam Run t-shirts – Pictures have been received from last year’s People’s Choice winner. The Ellertons will work with Two-Lane Apparel who is interested in supplying the Dam Run shirts. The pictures will be given to Two-Lane asking them to work on a design proof for review. Two-Lane currently does not print dash plaques but they are looking into the possibility of doing so.
- Dam Run registration – It was suggested that the Dam Run registration include an option to order shirts along with the registration. Should add this to the registration form this year to see how it works. The shirts would need to be pre-paid with the pre-paid registration. This would allow us to make sure individuals get the size of shirts they need and avoid needing to re-order and mail shirts after the Dam Run.
- Northridge Plaza show – Members voted unanimously to host a Street Masters vehicle show on April 22-23, 2017, Saturday & Sunday,

at the Plaza. This show will be held in conjunction with the Scouts Pinewood Derby and may also include some drag cars.

- Newsletter – Members discussed the possibility of publishing the newsletter quarterly rather than the current monthly publication. This may be a good option during the fall and winter but a monthly publication during the active summer months may be important. It was decided to continue with the monthly publication and revisit this issue in the fall.
- Meeting time – Marlin proposed 7:00 p.m. as a new meeting time. Hearing no objections, members agreed to give the new time a try beginning in March.
- By-laws – The very old, if not the original, by-laws were located and have been placed on the website. Marlin distributed some basic amendments needed to bring them up-to-date. A decision needs to be made on how, according to the by-laws, amendments need to be made. We may need to notify the full membership of the changes by mail or email before final action can be taken at a meeting. It was suggested that we also may need to notify the Secretary of State's office of changes. Marlin will schedule a meeting of the Board of Directors to further review this process and finalize amendments for presentation to the membership.
- American Cancer Society – In past years the club has made donations to the cancer society or cancer fundraisers. The membership voted unanimously to donate \$200 to Deb and Frank Eich to assist with Deb's ongoing treatments.

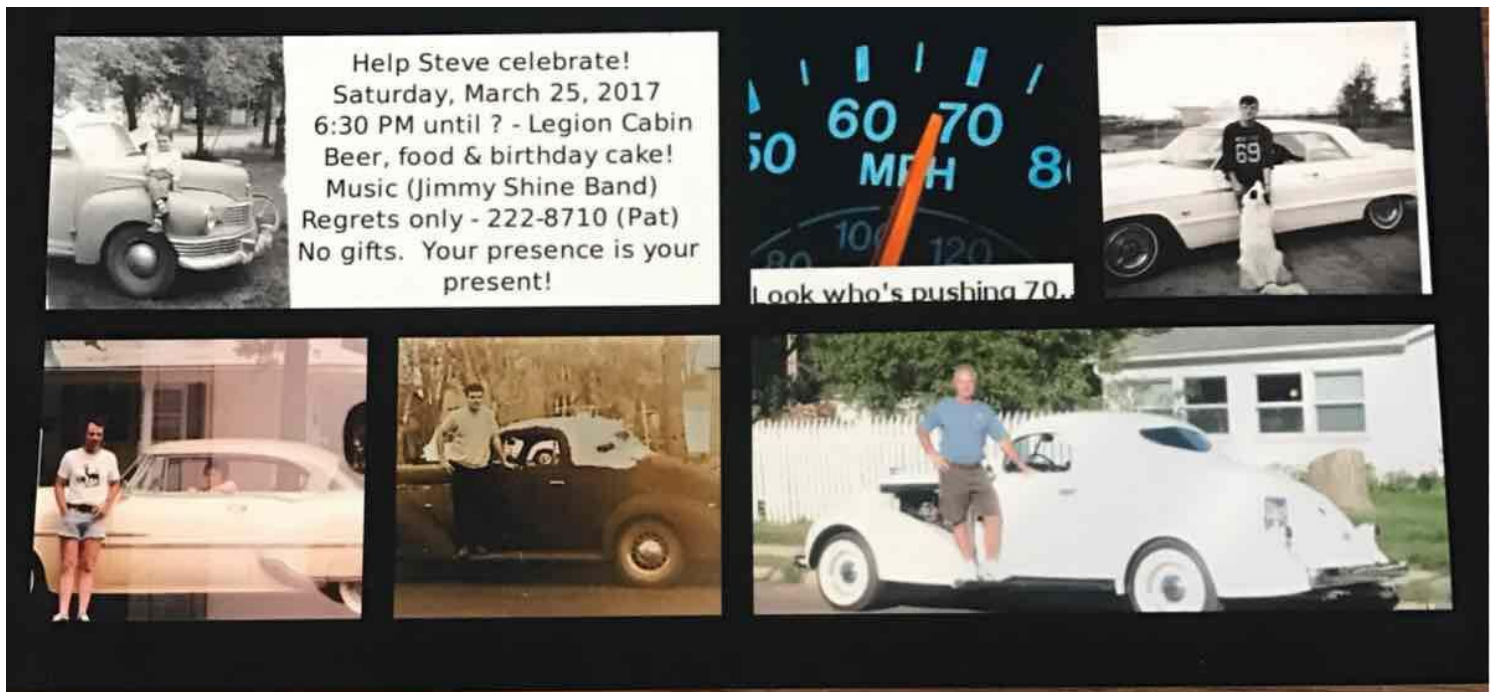

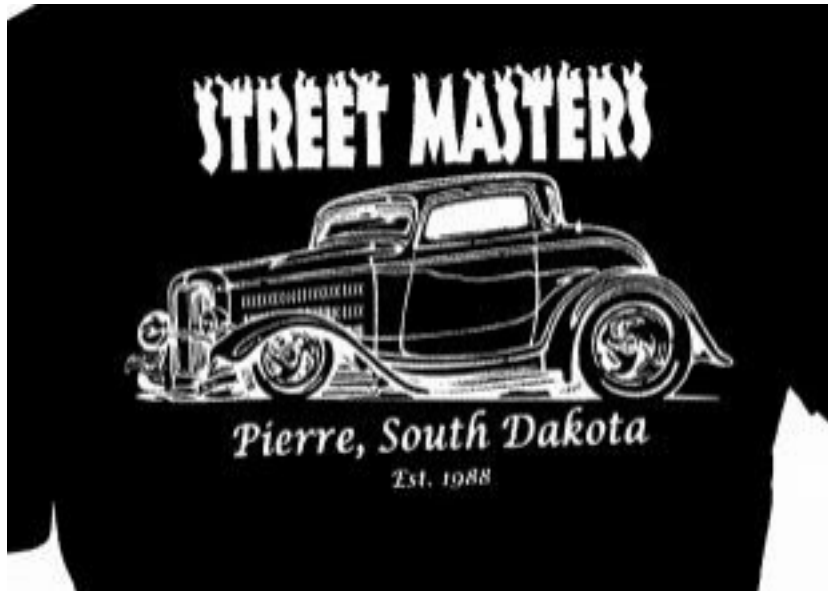
