STREET MASTERS MEETING SUMMARY – August 15, 2016

Members present: 28

Meeting called to order by Ann Curtis, President. The July 2016 minutes and treasurer's report were adopted.

Old Business

2016 Dam Run: Frank Eich was complemented for his efforts as chairman. Members offered possible changes that may be helpful in the future. A more organized line through the Saturday evening buffet was suggested. A possible idea may be numbering the tables and then the people at those tables would go through the line when that number is called. Another suggestion was to allow our guests to be served first and then club members. We may also want to set out a few salads at a time rather than serving all of them at once. Another suggestion was to investigate the possibility of moving the meal to another location. Finding a large enough facility for a minimal fee may be difficult so it was suggested that we meet with the owner of the Lariat Lanes to get his suggestions on how to accommodate more people during the Saturday meal.

All of these ideas and suggestions will be considered when planning begins on the 2017 Dam Run. In general, positive comments and complements were received from our guests; specifically in regard to hosting the gearhead reunion on Pierre

Street. Another idea was to incorporate a lady's poker walk among the stores on Pierre Street if an adequate number of stores would stay open. If the number of vehicles at the show-n-shine continues to increase, the possibility of moving the show to the parking lot in the back of the Capital was discussed. There were a number of comments and suggestions concerning the ballot. A redesign/labeling of the ballot will be considered.

New Business

Fort Pierre Bi-Centennial: The Ft. Pierre Mayor Gloria Hansen approached Ann Curtis concerning the possibility of having some Street Masters function in Ft. Pierre to assist them in celebrating Ft. Pierre's Bi-Centennial in 2017. Dale Hunsley informed the group that someone was willing to bring one of the original bat mobiles to Pierre. There would be a charge for this but perhaps it could be incorporated in a Ft. Pierre event. A general discussion ensued with no decisions made.

Street Masters Website: Marlin Roseland was complimented on the high quality of the Pierre Street Masters website. His efforts to maintain the site are appreciated. Marlin mentioned that the club is also on Facebook. These addresses should always be included in all publications.

Membership Chairperson: The idea of establishing a membership chairman to recruit new members was suggested. This will be considered in January when new officers are elected.
